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


Figure 1 Patients registered in the Malaysian Psoriasis Registry by year (2007-2014)




Figure 2 Gender of psoriasis patients

Figure 3 Ethnicity of psoriasis patients




Figure 4 Positive family history




Figure 5 Age of onset of psoriasis




Figure 6 Percentage of co-morbidities in adult patients with psoriasis




Figure 7 Type of psoriasis




Figure 8 Severity of psoriasis




Figure 9 Type of nail psoriasis




Figure 10 Type of psoriatic arthropathy




Figure 11 Topical therapy





Figure 12 Phototherapy






Figure 14 Quality of life in adult patients with psoriasis




Figure 15 QoL impairment in adult psoriasis patients based on category of DLQI




Figure 16 Quality of life in paediatric patients with psoriasis




Figure 17 QoL impairment in patients with psoriasis based on category of cDLQI
